The South Central Employer Engagement Network is assisting a consortium of manufacturers in Bingen/White Salmon, WA with incumbent worker training. Richard Foster, Klickitat County Economic Development, has been tremendously helpful in convening manufacturing companies in the area to discuss their needs, desired trainings, and ensuring training requirements are met. The manufacturing consortium will be offering micro-electronic soldering training to a mix of around 20 employees. We are excited to move forward with the training and offer more in the future.
