## Rep. Johnson receives Presidential Medal for support of Pacific Northwest University of Health Sciences

Pacific Northwest University of Health Sciences (PNWU) in Yakima has awarded **Rep. Norm Johnson** with its Presidential Medal of Exemplary Service and Commitment.

PNWU President Dr. Keith Watson said **Johnson**, **R-Yakima**, was chosen for the medal because he has been a tenacious advocate for the university. Watson said **Johnson** was instrumental in securing \$800,000 of funding for development of PNWU graduate medical education. He also noted passage of **Johnson's** House Bill 1183 in 2011 that resulted in all medical students having access to clinical rotations, allowing them to train in hospitals throughout Washington.

"This is one of the greatest honors of my life. I have been a longtime supporter of access to quality, affordable health care in our state," said **Johnson**, a past trustee of Yakima Regional Hospital and Toppenish Providence Hospital. "There is greater demand for doctors, especially in the rural areas of Washington who are medically underserved. PNWU is the newest medical school in the Pacific Northwest in 60 years and it is preparing doctors to work in our underserved communities. I am proud to support the university's efforts to train new health care professionals who can be sent out into the field and meet the needs of our communities."

**Johnson** is serving his third term representing Washington's 14th Legislative District.

The award was given to **Johnson** during the university's commencement ceremony on May 10 at the Capitol Theatre in Yakima.
